

Regulations on the Sports Event of Burabike Fest 2019

An open bicycle race for amateurs and a bike ride as part of Burabike Fest will be held on August 24 and 25, 2019 in Burabai region of Akmola district. Start is at Rixos Borovoe

Organizers: Bulat Utemuratov Fund and Rixos Borovoe with the assistance of Akmola district Akimat

1. Registration and receipt of a start package

To participate in competition, you should pass registration and pay a fee at Burabike.kz. Registration of competitors ends on 23.08.2019 at 12:00 a.m.

Each registered member will receive a start package. Start packages will be issued from July 1 till August 23, 2019 in Astana, as well as on the day of the event at Rixos Borovoe. The address of the issue will be sent as a separate notice and published on the official website.

To receive a start package, the

competitor should provide the following documents:

- ID (to be copied/scanned);
- Written undertaking (waiver of claims) on responsibility for his/her health (original signed with a blue pen);
- E-ticket.

2. August 24 Bicycle Race Program

24.08.2019

August 23, 2019 Arrival and accommodation of competitors, trials

08:30 – 09:45 a.m. Registration of competitors and warming up

09:45 – 09:55 a.m. Formal opening of the tournament

09:55 – 10:00 a.m. Line-up of the competitors and pre-start briefing

10:00 – 01:00 p.m. Time limit start. Finish

01:00 – 01:30 p.m.

Note: Each competitor should have a copy of his/her ID Card, a start number and a completed “waiver of claims” acknowledgement. Competitors who declare their personal participation in the tournament and representatives of teams who were not present at the registration are not allowed to participate in the competitions.*

Sportsmen and teams that failed to appear at the pre-start briefing are not allowed to start.

Bike Ride – August of 25

25.08.2018

10:00 – 11:00 a.m. Registration/Receipt of start numbers (armlets)

11:00 – 00:30 p.m.– Start of the bike ride, new route of ~ 11 km

00.30 p. – 01:00 p.m. Finish and award ceremony

3. Competitors and participating organizations

The participants of competitions are amateurs (men and women) aged from 18 to 65. Amateur teams from Kazakhstan, CIS and non-CIS countries as well as personally announced sportsmen may also take part.

The age of competitors is determined by their full years on December 31, 2019.

At the time of registration, each participant in the bicycle race should choose a distance by him/herself (65 km or 35 km). By participating in competitions each sportsman should assess risks by him/herself, objectively assessing his/her physical abilities.

The declared competitors should not be active sportsmen at the time of the event.

The bike ride (11 km) will be held without age restrictions.

4. Technical Requirements:

Cycling kit:

The participants are allowed to the competitions with following items: a helmet, a bicycle uniform and a bicycle designed for this discipline, with serviceable equipment.

During training and basic cycling races, competitors must wear a helmets.

Headphones and other communication devices are prohibited.

Bicycle:

Sportsmen are only allowed to the cycling race of August, 24 with road bikes.

Any additional devices improving the stream-line form and extending the steering nozzles are prohibited.

5. Sports event system and management

Organizing Committee, together with the panel of judges, is entitled to amend the competition program after clarifying the list of competitors, and due to technical or weather conditions, and will announce this at the meeting of the panel of judges on August 24, 2019.

The Akimats of Akmola District and Shchuchinsk City ensure:

- public safety of competitors and informational support of the sport event in the regional media and on TV;

- motor road repair, road marking, payment to workers installing special-purpose equipment, and rental of vehicles to transport special-purpose equipment and fencings;

- preparation, designing, improvement of competition sites with due account for a large crowd of people;

- traffic police patrols, ambulances and reanimation car

6. Race route, distance and procedure of passage

Prior to the race, competitors are strongly recommended to drive the viewing laps around the racetrack.

The route of the bicycle race and the bike ride is available on the official festival website.

7. Health Care

For all competitions, the organizers appoint medical service of the appropriate health authority. The medical service should have a doctor and a nurse at official trainings and during the competitions, and at the finish of the highway as well.

On the highway, there must be two ambulances including reanimation cars, each having a team of a doctor, a nurse and a driver. Otherwise, the competitions shall not be held.

Registration of the relevant accounting and reporting documentation, acts for competitors' severe injuries, the ensuring of the timely dispatch of the injured to the nearest emergency station shall be the responsibility of the competition doctor.

It is only the competition doctor who may remove a competitor from the competitions for health reasons.

8. Quantitative and qualitative composition of the panel of judges

In all republic and international competitions held in the Republic of Kazakhstan, irrespective of who organizes them, the main panel of judges should consist of judges having an international category, the national highest category and the national category, and the remaining judges should have the national or first category.

Chief Judge – 1

Distance Controller – 1

Starter – 1

Finish Judge – 1

Chief Scorer – 1

Assistant to Starter – 1

Judge at the curve – 2

Bike check – 1

Informing Judge – 1

9. Scoring System

To determine the winner the finish site is equipped with a photo-finish and a special electronic recording equipment. The order of breasting the tape registered by the Finish Judge is essential for determining the winner, prize-winners and such other score points of different classifications.

10. Awarding winners and prize winners

Winners and prize-winners are awarded at the competitors' closure parade where the presence of all the competitors and their representatives is mandatory.

Competitors who fail to go to the medal ceremony will lose their diplomas and medals. The result shown by such sportsman in the competitions will be canceled.

11. Procedure for filing protests and consideration thereof

Protests may be filed to the Chief Judge and the Panel of Judges by the team representative and the competitor. Collective protests will ***not be accepted***.

Protests against the results of the competitions are to be filed during 30 minutes after the announcement of the results. A protest will not be considered if not filed in writing.

Protests will ***not be considered*** if it is a question of changing the result determined by the Finish Judge.

All protests related to exceptional incidents should be considered by the Panel of Judges immediately.

Decisions of the Panel of Judges made for controversial issues and protests during the competition process will be explained to the competitor and the team representatives with reference to the relevant paragraph of the international rules.

Information on a competitor's violation of the competition rules will be only accepted by the Panel of Judges from its members.
